§ 42.20 USE OF LAKES.

(A) Spring Lake and Lake Wackena shall be maintained and operated for the sole use of:

- (1) Residents of the Village of Walnut Creek and their immediate families;
- (2) Non-resident property owners of the Village of Walnut Creek and their immediate family members; and
- (3) Members of the Walnut Creek Country Club and their dependent family members.

(B) No one shall be authorized to use Lake Wackena or Spring Lake unless accompanied by a person authorized to use such lakes pursuant to division (A) above.

From The Chief 's Office: Greetings – Fraudulent scams that target innocent citizens over the telephone continue to occur in our community. The best defense to protect yourself from telephone scammers is to not conduct any business or exchange any personal financial information such as credit card numbers, checking account numbers or wiring of your funds via telephone. Here are some of the frequent scams that you should be aware of: A utility (gas, electric, water) bill is overdue and you need to make immediate payment. A tax bill (IRS, State or Municipal) has not been paid and you need to make immediate payment. Your computer has a virus and they need to remotely access your computer to fix it. A relative is in jail out of state or out of the country and you need to pay bail immediately. Remember; keep your personal financial accounts and information personal.
