81.02 DANGEROUS DOMESTIC ANIMALS; NUISANCE  
It shall be unlawful for any owner to keep on his lot or premises any domestic animal, the keeping of which results in such unsanitary conditions, odors or insect proliferation or which such domestic animal barks, cries, howls, yaps, fights or makes other noises, as to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood or general public and results in a neighborhood or public nuisance.

**COMPOST AREA**  
The Village compost area, located behind the playground, is for the use of the residents of Walnut Creek only. Please note if you have contractor that handles your landscaping, they can **only** bring the yard debris from your home if you are with them. We have had a problem with landscapers bringing debris from outside the Village and this is the only we can ensure the debris is from within the Village. Thank you for your cooperation.

## WALNUT CREEK POLICE DEPARTMENT

-Thank you to everyone for slowing down and abiding by our Village-wide speed limit of 30MPH. Our goal is not to write a bunch of tickets, but to make the roads in the Village safe for all to walk, jog and ride bikes. We will continue to monitor the speed of all vehicles driving in the Village. Pedestrians please make sure you are doing your part as well. If you are walking or jogging please do so facing traffic. If you are riding a bike then you should be riding "with" traffic. Also please make sure you are giving cars plenty of room by stepping off to the side of the road when possible and do not walk/bike two or more abreast.
